- Artworks are to be made from salvaged materials.
- Maximum size for 2D works: 1.5m x 1.5m, not more than 10Kg for hung works, and 50Kg for 3D works.
- Artworks are to be the original work of the artist.
- Artworks are to remain at the gallery for the duration of the exhibition.
- Artworks to be hung must have D-rings or wires to enable wall display.
- Sculptural work must be safe and freestanding.
- Artworks should not contain sharp, toxic or dangerous components that might cause injury.
- Kingborough Council reserves the right to reject any artworks deemed unsuitable or inappropriate.
- Kingborough Council is not responsible for loss or damage to any artworks.
- Artists are advised to insure their work against loss or damage.
- Kingborough Council reserves the right to photograph artworks in the exhibition for promotional and archival purposes, including posting images on the internet.
- Section winners will be judged along the following criteria:
 - transforming waste into a resource
 - creativity and aesthetic merit
 - craftsmanship and quality of work
 - innovation
