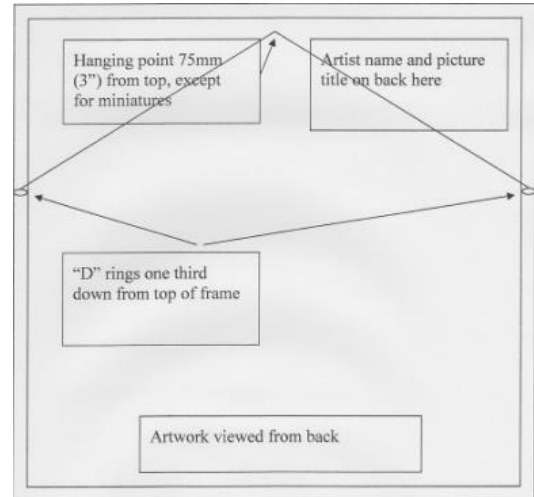


## 2022 KINGBOROUGH ART PRIZE – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – PLEASE READ

1. Entries are not valid without a completed entry form received by the closing date of Monday 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2022.
2. As there is less capacity to display artwork at the Hub, artwork entries will be cut off at 220. Any entries received after this number will not be accepted. So, get your entry in early!
3. All picture artwork to be mounted and wired for hanging, with the **KAP Receipt number** for this piece of Artwork, **title** and **artist's name** affixed to the rear upper right corner (see diagram).
4. **UNSIGNED ARTWORK/S CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
5. Clip frames not accepted.
6. No copies or wet artworks will be accepted.
7. Artists may enter up to 3 works, except for Ceramics and Jewellery, which can be up to 8 pieces.
8. All artworks are eligible for the Kingborough Art Prize.
9. All entries must be the original work of the artist, and not exhibited previously at KAP Exhibitions.
10. Please note a change to the maximum artwork size limit to be reduced to strictly 1 metre on any one side, inclusive of frame. This is because of the different hanging conditions at the HUB.
11. The organisers reserve the right to not exhibit an artwork.
12. All entries must be for sale and may be used for promotional and archival purposes.
13. A commission of 25% will be charged on all sales. Please allow for the commission when pricing your artwork.
14. The judge's decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. Entries to be delivered to The Kingborough Community Hub, 1 Goshawk Way, Kingston from 1200 till 1600 on Tuesday 4/10/22.
16. Freight entries must include pre-paid return freight. Recommended courier is Fastway.
17. Unsold artworks must be collected strictly between 1500 - 1800 Sunday 09.10.22. Artworks may not be removed from the exhibition before 1500. You must bring your Artwork Receipt.
18. There are no facilities for post exhibition storage, therefore, artworks not collected by the above deadline will become the property of the Lions Club of Kingborough and may be sold for charity.
19. The organisers will take every care with all artworks but will not be held responsible for damage, loss, or theft of any item in the exhibition. Artists are advised to insure their own artworks.
20. In special circumstances, sold artwork/s can be removed from display, prior to the closure of the exhibition.
